

Approaching Hannover

From the north

Take the A7 towards Hannover / Kassel, leave at junction 56 Hannover-Kirchhorst and follow the A37 (B3 Messeschnellweg) towards Hannover / Messe

• From the east

Take the A2 towards Hannover / Dortmund, leave at junction 47 Hannover-Buchholz and follow the A37 (B3 Messeschnellweg) towards Hannover / Messe

• From the south

Take the A7 towards Hannover / Hamburg, leave at junction 60 Hannover-Süd and follow the A37 (B3 Messeschnellweg) towards Hannover / Messe

From the west

Take the A2 towards Hannover / Magdeburg / Berlin, leave at junction 48 Hannover-Ost and follow the A7 towards Kassel, leave at 58 Anderten and follow B65 towards Messe

Low emissions zone (emissions zone permit)

Hannover is not only an environmentally aware trade fair city. Since 1 January 2008 it has a low emissions zone. Like similar schemes in Berlin and Cologne, the low emissions zone is designed to bring about reduced particulate emissions in the city centre. The zone comprises large parts of the city centre within the expressway ring road and is demarcated by special "no entry" signs. Only vehicles displaying an emissions sticker or exempted vehicles may be driven in the low emissions zone.

Traffic management


Once in the vicinity of Hannover, visitors travelling by car will be guided to the Exhibition Grounds via autobahn and the designated "Messeschnellweg" (trade fair expressway). Traffic flows are managed by a centralized, electronically controlled routing system that is the only one of its kind in Germany. It embraces:

- Traffic control systems on the autobahns A2 and A7
- Additional dynamic route guidance at autobahn junctions
- The traffic routing system on the trade fair expressway
- The parking guidance system on the trade fair ring road

Information displayed by these road signs and signals is based on traffic data that is generated and calculated electronically. This means that traffic jams and other hold-ups are identified immediately, allowing the best routes to and from the Exhibition Grounds to be displayed at all times.
