	<p>there trams provide service to the exhibition center.</p> <p>Trains: Trains traveling north and south stop at the "Hannover Messe / Laatzen" station located to the west of the exhibition center. A skywalk with a moving walkway runs from there to the show (Hall 13).</p> <p>Visitors arriving at Hannover Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) can take the tram to the exhibition center.</p> <p>Trams: Tram lines 8 and 18 provide service from Hannover Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) to the exhibition center (North 1 and 2 gates). Tram lines 6 and 16 run from the city center (stops "Kröpcke" and "Aegidientorplatz") to the east side of the exhibition center.</p> <p>Public transportation map for the Greater Hannover area: www.efa.de</p> <p>By car: Arrival via A2, A7, A37 and A352 autobahns. Navigation device target address is Hermesallee, Hannover. The way to the exhibition center ("Messe") is signposted.</p>
