Getting to the show

Getting to the show by train

The Hannover Messe/Laatzen station is about 400 meters from the WEST 1 entrance to the showgrounds. You can get from the station to the grounds on foot via the covered Skywalk, or you can take a shuttle bus. Many trains on Germany's north-south routes make special stops at the Hannover Messe/Laatzen station when trade fairs are on.

Getting to the show by car

To reach the Exhibition Center, simply enter the Hannover destination "Hermesallee" into your navigation system or follow the "Messe" road signs.

Emission zone

Hannover is not just an environmentally aware exhibition city; it is also a city with an official "emission zone" (Umweltzone), created to lower the health risks associated with diesel exhaust particulates. The "emission zone" includes large sections of the city encircling the city center. Only vehicles bearing the appropriate emission sticker are permitted to enter the emission zone.
