The **RetCon Rettungsdienstkongress INTERSCHUTZ** on 11 and 12 June in Leipzig serves as a perfect complement to the exhibition.

KEYNOTE DISASTER RELIEF

Recent events have illustrated the challenges posed by cross-border cooperation in civil defence and disaster relief. INTERSCHUTZ 2010 is an ideal showcase for state-of-the-art developments in technology and logistics that will prove crucial

in mastering the complex demands of disaster management in the future.

KEYNOTE FIRE PREVENTION

Prevention remains the best strategy in combating the dangers of fire and smoke. For this reason fire protection is again a central theme at INTERSCHUTZ in 2010. GERMAN FIREFIGHTERS' CONVENTION

LEIPZIG LIGHTS UP

In June 2010 Leipzig will become the undisputed focus for fire-fighters in Germany. INTERSCHUTZ 2010 coincides with another important event in Leipzig – the 28th German Fire-fighters' Convention, thus making the city a magnet for visitors from Germany and other countries world-wide. The combination of two top-flight events promises many highlights and is expected to attract more than 100,000 professionals to this historic location.

For 156 years the traditional convention of Germany's fire brigades has been a major event for Germany's firefighters. Held every ten years, this top event is a celebration of volunteer firefighters, and illustrates the progress and development of the nation's fire brigades. With countless events on key themes such as youth work, civic commitment and cooperation with central Europe, it is clear that in 2010 the event will again address the burning questions of our time.

SUPPORTING PROGRAM

Apart from the broad range of innovative exhibits on display, a varied and exciting supporting program contributes in no small way to the success of INTERSCHUTZ. Panel discussions and conferences on topical issues provide an ideal opportunity for the exchange of know-how, while on the open-air site spectacular practical demonstrations prove as entertaining as they are informative.

WIZARDS' DAY

For the first time in the history of INTERSCHUTZ an entire day has been designated to technical "wizards" and hobby engineers. A panel of professional judges, aided by visitors to the exhibition and readers of the trade publication "Feuerwehr-Magazin", will select what they believe is the ultimate idea to facilitate the work of firefighters. The three most innovative entrants will be named on the last day of the trade show and rewarded with a cash prize.

THE TOUGHEST FIREFIGHTER ALIVE

This competition to find the world's toughest firefighter will take place at INTERSCHUTZ for the second time. Once described as a battle between men who have fire-fighting in their blood, the four-day long competition is the absolute highlight of the supporting program. Attracting up to 20,000 spectators, it is a big crowd-puller. A knock-out system pits two contestants against each other in different events until one of the 140 participants – the "last man standing" – takes the title home.

CITY LIGHTS

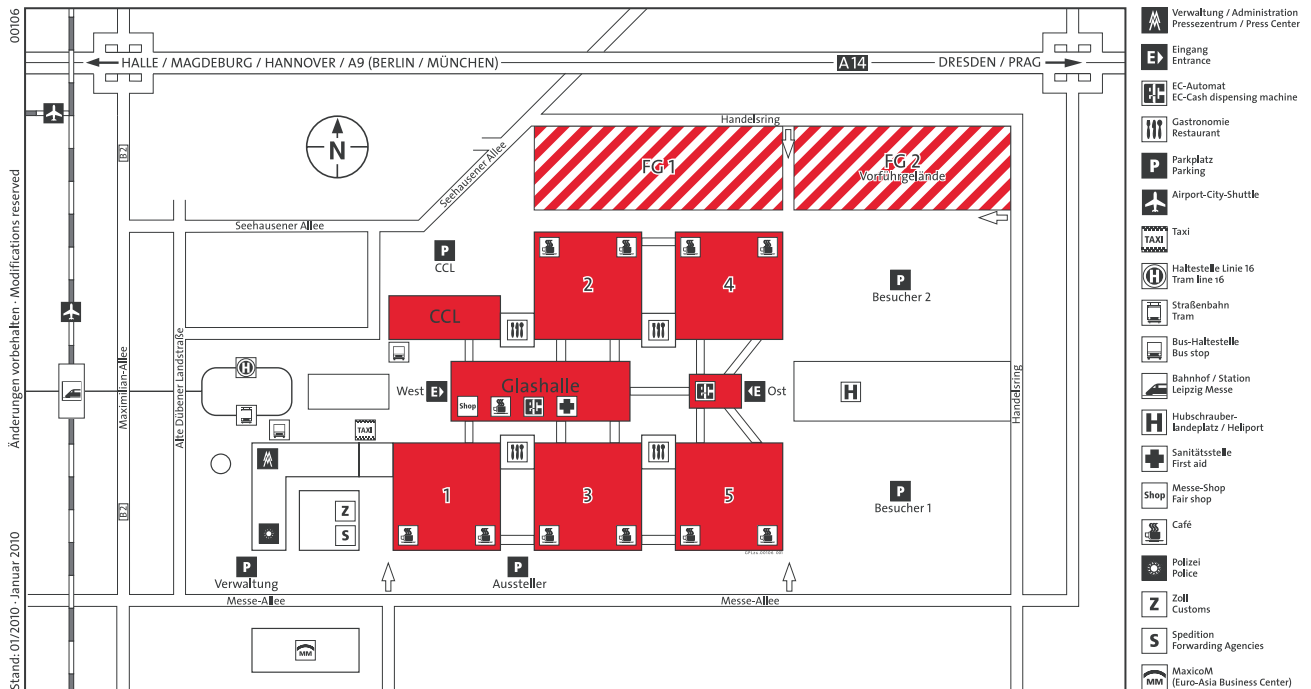
